



## *Embassy of Italy to the People's Republic of China*

The Embassy of Italy to the People's Republic of China is looking for an **Occupational Health Physician**, in accordance with the Italian legislation - D. Lgs. 81/2008 + subsequent modifications and supplements, and the interministerial decree n. 51/2012.

Candidates with the requisites listed below can apply by handing in their application by **12.30 hours of Monday 24<sup>th</sup> August 2015**. Applications shall only be delivered by hand to the Embassy of Italy to the People's Republic of China located in Beijing, Sanlitun, Dong Er Jie n. 2. No other means of transmission or delivery to the Embassy shall be accepted and no exception shall be made in this respect.

Eligible candidates are local practitioners, possessing the general requisites provided under art. 38 item 4 of D. Lgs. 163/06 and possessing professional qualifications equal to those provided for by D. Lgs. N. 81/2008. Failure to possess these requisites shall lead to exclusion. Eligible candidates shall be able to provide health services with the same parameters set by the Italian national health plan. Eligible candidates can also be cooperating with a local public or private structure under agreement with the Embassy of Italy in Beijing.

The application must include an offer for the professional services herein detailed, inclusive of costs, taxes, insurances, safety costs, social security and any other fee. Failure to include the aforementioned offer shall lead to exclusion from the selection. No further negotiation on the initial proposed fees shall be possible afterwards.

The offer shall be valid from September 1<sup>st</sup> 2015 to December 31<sup>st</sup> 2015.

The Occupational Health Physician, within the framework of the Prevention and Protection Service and in close cooperation with the Employer and the Prevention and Protection Supervisor (PPS), shall be responsible for sanitary supervision in accordance with D. Lgs. 81/2008, including:

- a) risk evaluation and preparation of the Risk Evaluation Paper ex art. 29 item 1 of D. Lgs. 81/2008 in cooperation with the Employer and the PPS, informing the Workers' Representative for Safety;
- b) preventive medical evaluation to ascertain the absence of conditions against the worker's assignment in order to evaluate his/her fitness to that specific assignment;
- c) periodic medical evaluation of the health condition of the employees and assessment of their fitness to perform their specific assignments. The timing of the assessments, if

not specified by the relevant norms, is generally once per year minimum. This timing can be revised, in line with the risk evaluation;

c) medical assessment upon request of the workers - if the Occupational Health Physician deems it related to professional risks or health conditions which could worsen because of their assignments – in order to evaluate their fitness to perform that specific assignment;

d) medical evaluation in the case of change of assignment in order to assess fitness to that specific assignment;

e) medical evaluation upon termination of the work contract in the cases provided for by the law;

f) pre-employment medical evaluation;

g) medical evaluation to assess the workers' fitness to resume their work in the case of an uninterrupted absence for health reasons longer than 60 days.

2-bis. Pre-employment medical evaluations can be performed by decision either of the Employer or the Occupational Health Physician.

The relevant expenditure section of the Embassy budget is n. 1613.

The official in charge of the procedure is Mr. Simone Razzauti, appointed with official decree on 14 August 2015.

The decision to contract in connection with this procedure is n.33 of 14 August 2015 published on 14 August 2015.

Services are provided at fixed prices, any price variation shall be excluded.

The appointment will be based on the price proposed, after verifying both its adequacy and the requisites declared in the application. The applicants are invited to present, together with their application, additional documentation to justify their offered price.
